CHICAGO, Nov. 14.—Abraham Solodar, 44 years old, Jewish poet and scholar, died suddenly today of a heart attack in his room at 436 South Central Park Avenue. Mr. Solodar recently received his Master of Arts degree at Northwestern University. He had been engaged in a translation of Walt Whitman's works into Hebrew.

In addition to editing the Hebrew Dorenu, a monthly Jewish paper, Mr. Solodar taught classes at the Hebrew Theological College and the College of Jewish Studies.

His widow and two children are in Palestine.
